From Wolves to Geysers to Outlaws: 16-Tour Audio Collection Brings Jackson Hole to Life

Most Tours Free; Expert-Narrated Experiences Cover Grand Teton, Yellowstone, and Beyond

Jackson Hole, WY — Summer visitors to Jackson Hole, Grand Teton National Park, and Yellowstone can now explore the region with a local guide in their pocket. Jackson Hole-based TravelStorysGPS has assembled a 16-tour collection of GPS-triggered audio experiences that bring the area's wildlife, geology, Indigenous history, pioneer heritage, public lands, and legendary characters to life while visitors drive, walk, and explore.

Thirteen tours are **free**; three premium deep-dive tours from TheParkGuide are available for \$19.99. Fifteen tours are available now, with a sixteenth launching at the end of June.

Three of the tours — Yellowstone National Park, Historic Downtown Jackson, and Grand Teton National Park — are also available entirely in Mandarin, expanding access for Chinese-speaking visitors exploring one of the country's most iconic national park gateways.

Tours feature GPS-triggered narration that plays automatically as visitors drive or walk — no tapping, no searching, and no cell signal required after downloading.

"Visitors come to Jackson Hole for the scenery and wildlife, but the stories behind this place are just as extraordinary," said Story Clark, founder and CEO of TravelStorysGPS. "These tours help people understand what they're seeing in real time — from wolves and wildfire recovery to Indigenous history, geysers, homesteaders, and the landscapes that make this region unforgettable."

THE 16 TRAVELSTORYS™ JACKSON HOLE TOURS

1. Grand Teton National Park

Driving, Free

Three tours in one, with separate tracks for Wildlife & Landscapes, Local History, and Just for Kids along the park's popular inner road.

Highlights: Jenny Lake, Jackson Lake Lodge, Menor's Ferry, Mount Moran, moose, grizzlies, elk, eagles

2. Grand Teton by TheParkGuide

Driving, Premium — \$19.99

An in-depth park guide covering every paved road in Grand Teton National Park, plus surrounding

gateway areas from Jackson toward Yellowstone.

Highlights: Mormon Row, Oxbow Bend, Signal Mountain, Jackson Lake Dam

3. Yellowstone National Park

Driving, Free

A classic Southwest Grand Loop tour from West Thumb to Madison Junction, with stories of geothermal wonders, wildlife, mountain men, and Native history.

Highlights: Grand Prismatic Spring, Old Faithful, Firehole River, Shoshone Point

4. Yellowstone North by TheParkGuide

Driving, Premium — \$19.99

A deep-dive tour through Yellowstone's northern loop, known for wolves, grizzlies, bison herds, dramatic geology, and sweeping wildlife habitat.

Highlights: Lamar Valley, Mammoth Hot Springs, Grand Canyon of Yellowstone

5. Yellowstone South by TheParkGuide

Driving, Premium — \$19.99

A detailed guide to Yellowstone's southern loop, including geyser basins, hot springs, mud pots, and some of the park's most famous thermal features.

Highlights: Old Faithful, West Thumb, Grand Prismatic Spring, Biscuit Basin

6. Historic Downtown Jackson

Walking, Free

Created with the Jackson Hole Historical Society & Museum, this walking tour explores the cowboys, homesteaders, entrepreneurs, and outlaws who shaped downtown Jackson.

Highlights: Town Square, Wort Hotel, Million Dollar Cowboy Bar

7. Follow the Flames

Driving, Free

Presented by The Nature Conservancy and the Greater Yellowstone Fire Action Network, this tour tells the dramatic story of the 1988 Yellowstone fires and the park's remarkable recovery.

Highlights: West Yellowstone, Old Faithful Inn, Northern Arapaho perspectives, wildfire ecology

8. Outer Grand Teton National Park

Driving, Free

Two tracks explore the wildlife, landscapes, art, history, and culture of the Greater Yellowstone Ecosystem outside the park's inner road.

Highlights: Mormon Row, Moulton Barn, Kelly flood, iconic wildlife habitat

9. Wildlife Highways in Teton County

Driving, Free

An eye-opening look at migration corridors, wildlife crossings, seasonal travel routes, and the animals that move through the Jackson Hole landscape.

Highlights: Moose, elk, wolves, pronghorn, bighorn sheep, swans, eagles

10. Teton Village Experience

Walking, Free

An insider's guide to Teton Village, with separate summer and winter tracks covering the tram, wildlife, music, ski culture, and local legends.

Highlights: The Mangy Moose, Walk Festival Hall, Jackson Hole Mountain Resort

11. Teton Village Road

Driving, Free

A scenic route along the Snake River corridor and Moose-Wilson Road, connecting Jackson to Teton Village and, in summer, Grand Teton National Park.

Highlights: Rendezvous Park, moose habitat, ranching history, skiing, biking

12. Jackson Hole Airport

Driving/Walking, Free

Two tracks explore the airport's sustainability initiatives and its exceptional Art & the Wild West collection. Indoor stories are triggered manually.

Highlights: Bronzes, murals, paintings, water conservation, energy-saving design

13. Jackson to Teton Pass

Driving, Free

Three tracks — Local History, Wildlife & Landscapes, and Just for Kids — guide travelers up the switchbacks to Teton Pass.

Highlights: Teton Pass summit, earthquakes, backcountry skiing, wolves, moose, Native history

14. Explorers & Native Homelands

Driving, Free

A journey through the valley's long human history, from Shoshone and Bannock travel corridors to early explorers and expeditions.

Highlights: Deadman's Bar, Antelope Flats, Snake River, Teton Range

15. Teton Adventures

Driving, Free

Produced by Teton County Search and Rescue, this tour shares stories of first ascents, epic descents, avalanches, and daring rescues in the Tetons.

Highlights: Grand Teton, Mount Owen, climbing, skiing, mountain rescue

16. Geology Guide to Grand Teton — Coming Soon

Driving, Free

Launching at the end of June, this tour explores 2.7 billion years of geologic history, from ancient seas and glaciers to the active Teton Fault.

Highlights: Glacier View Turnout, Snake River Overlook, Gros Ventre Slide

HOW TO ACCESS THE TOURS

1. Download the free TravelStorys app on iOS or Android.
2. Search "Jackson Hole" or any of the tour names listed above.
3. Download chosen tours before heading out; tours work offline after downloading.
4. Start driving or walking. GPS automatically triggers narration at key points along the route.
